Dear Resident:

Electric Transmission Texas (ETT) and CPS Energy are jointly developing plans to build a 138-kilovolt transmission line in portions of Medina, Atascosa, and Bexar Counties, Texas. This new power line will connect the existing ETT Lytle Substation, located off County Road 6712 in Medina County, to CPS Energy's Lytle Substation, located on Farm-to-Market (FM) 2790 on the Bexar/Atascosa county line north of Lytle, Texas.

The routing of this power line has been handled through a Routing and Siting Process, which included an open house, a detailed environmental assessment, many conversations with land owners and a public input meeting. The project team presented the recommended route to the CPS Energy Board of Trustees at its regularly scheduled January 31st Board meeting.

The CPS Energy Board of Trustees approved the recommended route in CPS Energy's service boundary at its Board meeting held on Monday, February 28, 2011. A copy of the approved route for the transmission line in CPS Energy's service area is enclosed and is also posted on the CPS Energy Web site (cpsenergy.com).

CPS Energy will begin contacting property owners along the approved route in order to gather information needed for timely construction of the power line. The projected completion date of the Project is April 2013.
