RESULTS OF OPINION SURVEY MARCH 10

Best Outcome: 9 in favor of public uses
8 in favor of mixed use
5 in favor of 5 different uses*
3 in favor of retail
2 in favor of apartments
2 in favor of offices
1 in favor of condominiums
0 in favor of corporate campus

Worst Outcome: 6 opposed to a corporate campus
5 opposed to apartments
3 opposed to offices
3 opposed to condos
